Regular Board Meeting  
April 12, 2021 7:00 P.M.**

Meeting was called to order by Chuck Maziasz, Supervisor at 7:00 pm by. Pledge of allegiance recited.

**Additions/Deletions to agenda – None**

**Action Items:**

Garbage Bid – Only received one bid from PAC Sanitation. Pricing the same as last contract. The monthly cost of \$1,245.00 with a six-bag limit of household trash to be picked up on the last Thursday of the month. No fuel surcharge. Residents will be offered a discount rate of \$12.80 a month for the remaining weeks of the month. The contract is for May 2021 – April 2024. Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to accept the proposed bid for the next three years. All ayes. Motion carried.

May 4<sup>th</sup> Special Election workers- Teresa Sullivan, Clerk gave a list of workers for the May election and recommended chairperson wages at \$300.00, election workers at \$250.00 for a 16-hour work period. Hours worked over 16 hours or less than will be \$15.00 per hour, Motion by Steve Crusoe and seconded by Scott Eno to pay election workers at the recommended rate. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Consent Agenda** – Motion by Scott Eno, seconded by Teresa Sullivan to accept the consent agenda, March 8, 2021 minutes, March Financial Report, Township expenditures in the amount of \$80,308.67 and Oak Hill cemetery expenditures in the amount of \$431.68. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Meeting Report-** Charlie Veneros reported on the Cheboygan County Road Commission. Chuck Maziasz asked if the reports should be included in the board packet that Charlie receives at the meetings and was decided that it will be included.

**Old Business**

AT&T- Clerk Teresa Sullivan received the internet device and tested with her own laptop. Scott Eno also tested connectivity and is working fine.

Road improvement list – Treasurer Charlie Veneros did not receive any road improvement suggestions from any board members. There is a concern of cracks on the edges of Long Lake Rd. Brent from the CCRC will look into it. Discussion on other roads that need improvement.
