

**Aloha Township
Regular Meeting
August 10, 2020 7:00 P.M.**

Board members present: Chuck Maziasz, Steve Crusoe, Scott Eno, Teresa Sullivan, Charles Veneros.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chuck Maziasz. Pledge was recited by all.

Additions/Deletions to agenda – Recycling site, Aloha 212 Hwy., Township Clerk, Broad Band Special Assessment. Motion by Steve Crusoe and seconded by Scott Eno to approve agenda with 4 additions.

Information Reports –

Tim MacArthur – Reported on the Nuisance Ordinance Agreement that the sheriff department would like all the townships to adopt for a uniform enforcement of public nuisances that will be enforced by the deputies. MacArthur stated this is not a Blight Ordinance but a Nuisance Ordinance that Aloha currently has in place. He stated that the township will need to monitor the situation and contact the sheriff to write a ticket. MacArthur stated that the tickets written will not be enforceable unless a prosecutor is hired and that the court costs would be the townships responsibility.

Charlie Veneros stated that the township spent a lot of money for the Blight Ordinance already in place. Chuck Maziasz motioned to table for further review.

Charlie Veneros stated from the July minutes that the Blight Ordinance was clarified to Ed Delana that we had one in place.

MTA, Cheboygan County Road, Oak Hill Cemetery

MTA - covered election information

Cheboygan County Road Commission -Charlie Veneros stated there was nothing more than what was in the correspondence.

Oak Hill cemetery - Chuck Maziasz reviewed the items covered; the Lawrence gravesite was redone and location of the Brady gravesite.

Old Business:

Joyce Barr foundation -Chuck Maziasz to contact Joe Drake or Lance McKay for foundation work. Charlie Veneros motioned that Chuck Maziasz to contract with a laborer in the best interest of the township, supported by Steve Crusoe.

Ruth Bell stated that the screen to the men's bathroom is torn and a couple of windows did not work well. Windows were fixed by the board.
Steve Crusoe to get a knob for the hall stove.
Hall keys – everyone who needed keys received new ones.

New Business:

Teresa Sullivan commented on the August 4th election results. 266 voters – 117 walk-ins, 206 absentee ballots sent with 149 returned.

Charlie Veneros stated that the trustees should review and sign off on the monthly bills. The minutes should reflect the approval of monthly expenditure amount for the Township and Oak Hill Cemetery. Motion by Charlie Veneros and seconded by Scott Eno. MC

Aloha Hwy 212 – complaint of speeding. Charlie Veneros stated that the township has no jurisdiction on speeding limits. Discussion where the speed signs are posted. M-Dot to do a study.

Chuck Maziasz asked if possible that all reports/information be submitted to the Clerk by the Wednesday before the meeting in case of any discrepancies that need to be resolved before the weekend.

Recycling Area – Steve Crusoe commented that the grass is not being cut and there is debris around the bins. Chuck Maziasz to contact county.

Broadband 5673 Special Assessment – if it passes there will be a special assessment for high speed.
