

**Aloha Township
Regular Board Meeting
Aloha Township Hall
July 12, 2021 7:00 P.M.**

Present: Supervisor Chuck Maziasz, Trustee Steve Crusoe, Clerk Teresa Sullivan, Treasurer Charles Veneros, Trustee Scott Eno.

Meeting was called to order by Chuck Maziasz, Supervisor at 7:00 pm by. Pledge of allegiance recited.

Additions/Deletions to agenda – Motion by Steve Crusoe, supported by Scott Eno to accept agenda.

Guest – Aaron Gauthier updated 53rd circuit court. Next week will be the first jury trial. He commented that criminal and civil cases can be viewed online on U Tube. The 53rd court recovery program is working well.

Nadine Delana – Nadine was unable to attend and an update on the library was given by Ed Delana. The library had its election of officers. Ed distributed flyers for The Coastie Story that will be presented entire month of August.

Action Items:

Cheboygan County Humane Society contract in the amount of \$750 – Motion by Steve Crusoe, supported by Scott Eno. Motion carried.

Consent Agenda – Motion by Scott Eno, seconded by Steve Crusoe to accept the consent agenda, June 14, 2021 minutes, June Financial Report, Township expenditures in the amount of \$33,610.08 and Oak Hill Cemetery expenditures in the amount of \$1,687.58. Motion by Charlie Veneros to correct the minutes of June 14, 2021 to delete his name as one of the contacts regarding any questions on the new tax codes that will be on the tax billing. All questions are to be directed to Clayton McGovern, Assessor.

Meeting Report-Charlie Veneros reported that the Cheboygan County Road Commission is in need of new trucks which takes three years to receive and South River Road is being delayed due to MDot. Chuck Maziasz attended the MTA meeting that covered the county's blight ordinance that they are asking townships to accept. Comment asked if the township was enforcing the ordinance because there are several properties that violate the ordinance. Chuck Maziasz stated that Oak Hill Cemetery had issues regarding a veteran's plague and a cracked monument that the owner believes was vandalized.

Old Business

Website – Motion by Steve Crusoe, supported by Charlie Veneros to pay the last installment for the website and for all members to send in their suggestions to get the website launched. Motion carried.

Hall rental-Discussion regarding reopening the hall for resident use. Steve Crusoe stated that the hall is very small and not equipped for parties. The Long Lake Association held their annual meeting at the hall. It was suggested that the hall not be available for parties, only organization meetings. Motion carried that the hall outside of township activities will be only available for organization meetings.

Hall ramp- Teresa Sullivan received the specifications from Steve Crusoe for the ramp and will put the ad in for bids to be opened at the August meeting.
