Present: Supervisor Chuck Maziasz, Trustee Steve Crusoe, Trustee Scott Eno, Clerk Teresa Sullivan, Treasurer Dana Stempky.

Meeting was called to order by Chuck Maziasz, Supervisor at 7:00 pm by. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Additions/Deletions to agenda – Add: Recycling bins, Long Lake Special Assessment and correction to Aloha Township Expenditures for a check written after board packets went out. Motion by Steve Crusoe, supported by Dana Stempky to accept agenda with additions. Motion Carried.

Information Reports –

Ed Delana stated that Nadine Delana, Library Representative, will be attending the January meeting. Update from Nadine was that the library board seats are all filled.

Consent Agenda –

Minutes - Regular meeting minutes for November 8, 2021, Financial Report – November 2021, Oak Hill Cemetery Expenditures \$296.33, Aloha Township Expenditures \$9,080.41. Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to accept the consent agenda with an adjustment to the Aloha Township Expenditure from \$9,000.41 to \$9,080.41 for a check written after packets were sent out. Motion carried.

Correspondence – all reviewed. Letter from Sue Brown requesting a sign at Olsen Rd. and Whiting Rd. CCRC will replace the sign at Olsen Rd., however Whiting Rd. is a private road and the cost to put up a sign would be the responsibility of the residents.

Meeting Report- Treasurer, Dana Stempky updated on Cheboygan County Road Commission. Matt Hall is the new engineer for CCRC. Chuck Maziasz to attend January meeting to give update for Aloha. Clerk, Teresa Sullivan taking required MTA election courses.

Old Business

ARPA funds- Dana Stempky stated that the status on receiving funds is “in process.” The first installment should be \$47,938.00.

Township hall attic- – Chuck Maziasz stated that the project took three days to complete. Discussion that the hall should be treated to keep the mouse problem under control. Steve Crusoe suggested to call Straits Area Pest Control to do the annual treatment. Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Dana Stempky to contact Straits Area Pest Control to treat the hall for rodent control as long as it is under \$300.

New Business –

CNB Safe Deposit Box - Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno, authorizing Dana Stempky and Teresa Sullivan to have the keys to access the safe deposit box.

Little Canada Road culvert – Steve Crusoe stated that the culvert is too small to handle excessive rain and that the water is going over the road. Dana Stempky stated, per past treasurer’s request, to replace the culvert to a small one. Dana said that if it is replaced to a larger culvert, it could be considered a project with ENGLE involved that would increase the cost. Chuck Maziasz will contact Brent from CCRC before he leaves his position next week.

Oak Hill Cemetery Ordinance – Steve Crusoe said he had a copy of the ordinance and rules and that it stated that cremations are to be in a vault. Teresa Sullivan read cemetery meeting notes dated June 15, 2016 that the board agreed to use 12X12 block to be put on top of the urn. Discussion to keep the flag up at the cemetery and not take it down for the winter.

Aloha Township website – Board reviewed the website. Chuck Maziasz will contact Abuzz with all changes to be made.

Recycling Bins - The recycling bins are getting full again. Comment that Dan O’Henley should stop and push recyclable to the middle to make more room.

Long Lake Special Assessments – Teresa Sullivan received a call from a resident stating that the special assessment for her one piece of property was not charged on the tax bill and will be looked into. Discussion on how assessments are charged.
