

**Aloha Township
Regular Board Meeting
Aloha Township Hall
April 11, 2022 7:00 P.M.**

Present: Supervisor Chuck Maziasz, Trustee Steve Crusoe, Clerk Teresa Sullivan, Treasurer Dana Stempky, Trustee Scott Eno. **Absent:** None

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Chuck Maziasz at 7:00 pm. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Additions/Deletions to agenda – Add 911 Board appointment and hall ramp. Motion by Steve Crusoe and seconded by Scott Eno to accept agenda with additions. All ayes.

Information Reports – Nadine Delana, Library Representative reviewed events at the library: bids for annual audits, new chart of accounts beginning on July 2022, mask mandate lifted, new server, new library cards, census did not change library's class, blood drive, summer reading, movie's outdoor in the summer, succession plan in the works and salary comparison.

Guest – Assessor, Clayton McGovern discussed the Long Lake Special Assessment roll in 2021. It was determined that there might be some parcels that were omitted from the roll. Trustee, Steve Crusoe requested a more specific number of parcels that were not on the roll to determine what action to take. Clayton will email the report and special meeting is scheduled on April 19th at 6:00p.m. to review the reports and decide what action to take.

Action Items:

Alverno Fire Department By-Laws and Amended Inter-local Agreement for Maintenance and Continuation of Joint Fire Department were reviewed. Motion by Steve Crusoe and seconded by Scott Eno to approve the Amended Inter-Local Agreement. Roll call vote: Ayes: Stempky, Sullivan, Maziasz, Eno and Crusoe. No nays.

Consent Agenda –

Minutes - Regular meeting minutes for March 14, 2022, March 2022 Financial Report, Oak Hill Cemetery Expenditures \$346.56, Aloha Township Expenditures \$79,839.41. Motion by Scott Eno, seconded by Dana Stempky to accept the consent agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Correspondence – reviewed.

Meeting Report- MTA meeting discussed. MTA Chair, Steve Crusoe stated that the meeting reviewed the Ordinance Agreement what townships adopted.

Annual Oak Hill Cemetery Meeting with all townships – Chuck Maziasz is Chair.

Old Business –

Liability insurance for Jack Bell, groundskeeper. Chuck Maziasz stated that BKC Insurance confirmed that no additional insurance is required for the job that he does.

Hall ramp – Steve Crusoe suggested we advertise for bids to reconstruct the hall ramp again and state that it does not need to be done by October 1, 2022. Teresa Sullivan to place ad for bids.

New Business –

Pallister Road Dump and Gravel – there is an issue that debris is unloaded too close to the entrance gate and not dumped further in the back. Last year, the township paid to have it pushed back and it is currently getting too full of huge logs/stumps by the entrance. There is a concern that contractors are dumping debris not from Aloha residents. Steve Crusoe suggested to have contractors pay a charge per load. Chuck Maziasz stated that there is a log book when someone asks for the key. Decision to charge contractors per load tabled until May meeting. Chuck Maziasz stated that he recently had Everingham push back logs from the entrance.

Little Canada Road – road flooding issue. The culvert was changed to a smaller one, to replace the culvert it will need a DEQ permit, which is expensive. No action to be taken.

911 Board Appointment- Chuck Maziasz stated he is applying as an alternate.

Treasury Registration for ARPA Reporting- to be done at the Special Meeting scheduled on April 19th at 6:00 p.m.

Other Discussion-

Long Lake crack sealing- email was sent from CCRC if the township was interested in crack sealing Long Lake Rd. CCRC will be asked to resend the email.

SAM Registration - Expiration is not until May. Dana Stempky needs a letter from the board to change the administrator to her instead of Charlie Veneros. Maziasz states he does not have the login credentials to do the annual registration. Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to change the administrator to Dana Stempky for SAM.

Recycle Bins – Teresa Sullivan stated that the bins are full. Chuck Maziasz will contact Dan O’Henley.

Land Splits – Tom Sullivan 4300 Mann Rd. Motion by Steve Crusoe, supported by Scott Eno. Ayes: Crusoe, Eno, Maziasz, Stempky. Abstain: Sullivan

MTA Meeting – Scheduled on April 21, 2022, Inverness Township.

Public Comment –

Ed Delana stated that the Planning Commission only deals with junk vehicles for the Blight Ordinance.

Rick Charboneau and Top Notch commented on the dump/gravel on Pallister Rd. Top Notch stated that when he dumps, he pushes it to the back, but right now it is very muddy to go further back. Charboneau stated that he heard the pit was going to be closed. He suggested maybe selling sand to contractors to offset the cost of having the pit cleared to the back.

Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to adjourn at 8:45 p.m. Motion carried.
