Long Lake Association- Chuck Maziasz stated that the Long Lake Association has complaints regarding how the lake was treated with chemicals. No bills are to be paid until approval received from Long Lake Association.

Website – Chuck Maziasz asked if the board reviewed the site recently, and if everything looked okay.
