Action Items

Open bids for hall ramp and bathroom remodel – There were no bids received for the projects. Architect, Rich Clements was to send an invitation to contractors with the specs. There was a misunderstanding, and it was not done. Invitation to bid will be put in the paper for advertisement, one time only, with bids to be received by 5:00 p.m. July 10th. to be opened at the regular board meeting on the 10th.

Cheboygan Humane Society – Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to increase the contribution to \$1,000. Motion carried.

Commercial Fireworks Permit- Board received notification from Lucas Marshall, who is a summer resident on Devereaux Lake Rd., that obtained a Federal ATF permit to light off some commercial grade fireworks. There is no Township Ordinance or Resolution regarding fireworks. This permit is for township information, no action was taken.

MTA – Speaker was from Michigan Class who explained the investment opportunity for the township to collect a higher rate of interest on deposits.

Oak Hill Cemetery Meeting – Chuck Maziasz stated the meeting covered that no artificial flowers are permitted and will be enforced by removal. Steve Crusoe suggested putting up signs throughout the cemetery

that no artificial flowers are allowed and will be removed. There is a severely sunk grave that Ray Drake stated that he will fix. The project to fence the back 5 acres has been put out for bids to be opened at the next meeting. Chuck Maziasz suggested that the boundary stakes from the previous survey are verified before putting up the fence.

Long Lake Association – There is a tentative date for the water study and treatment. The new chemical that will be used will prohibit any activities on the lake for 24 hrs. The LLSA Annual meeting is set for June 24th at the Aloha Township Hall.

PIE&G Liaison Board Meeting – Chuck Maziasz attended the meeting and reported that the meeting covered PIE&G financial report, fiber installation, possible brown outs, and solar panels.

Old Business

Blight complaint – Chuck Maziasz stated that he gave the resident 15 days to clean up their property. He also received another complaint, but it was not blight but a matter for zoning or the sheriff department.

Septic system – Chuck Maziasz to research what needs to be done on replacing the septic system. Board would like to put an ad in the paper for bids to be opened at the July meeting.
