Meeting Reports

MTA – Attorney, Tim MacArthur was the guest speaker and spoke regarding the attempt of the Michigan Legislature to eliminate the townships to have control on Solar/Wind, and Sand and Gravel.

CCRC - Chuck Maziasz attended the annual meeting. He stated that Aloha roads are in good shape. There was a complaint regarding Long Lake Rd.

Oak Hill Cemetery – Teresa Sullivan stated that there will be no meeting scheduled in November and December. The board will be reviewing the revised Ordinance to make sure everything has been considered for updates.

Election Proposal 2022-02 and Elections - Now you know: Elections Update – Teresa Sullivan attended both meetings to learn of the many new updates and many questions still not answered. Election Proposal 2022-02 was a mandatory meeting that clerks to earn a completion certificate.

Old Business

Land Division – It is tabled until Attorney Tim MacArthur and Assessor Clayton McGovern get more information regarding non-compliant land splits.

New Business

Post card mailing for early voting dates - Teresa Sullivan stated that there will be a mailing to each household regarding the location for the early 9-day voting with the dates and time.

Seal Coat Estimate Mullett Lake Woods Shore Drive - Benton township needs to approve their road portion before the road can be considered for seal coat. Aloha received an estimate at \$51,600.00

Road Commission – White Cedar Rd. had several orders for gravel this year. Chuck Maziasz stated that he is the only one authorized to order gravel for the roads. Grading was discussed on White Cedar Rd. and other gravel roads. Steve Crusoe complained that when White Cedar Rd. gets graded, the gravel gets pushed up to the side of the road and there is hardly any left in some spots. He stated that when they snowplow the road all the gravel on the side of road gets thrown in the ditch.

EPS Security – Teresa Sullivan contacted the company for an estimate on a surveillance camera for the new wall ballot drop box that was ordered. It is mandatory that any boxes installed after October 2020 have a surveillance camera and old boxes installed prior to this date have until 2026 for camera.

Board Comment – Steve Crusoe asked if the doors were ordered for the hall.
