**Meeting Report**

Oak Hill Cemetery- Teresa Sullivan stated at the last meeting there were questions on who is going to trim the trees at the cemetery. Chairman, Eric Boyd reached out to both bidders and has information that will be addressed at the January 14, 2026 meeting. Steve Crusoe stated that trimming the oak tree branches should be done in the next two months when they are in a dormant stage to prevent the spread of wilt disease.

**Old Business –**

Generator line to the fire hall – Chuck Maziasz tried to contact Hobson Electric to get a bid on the cost. Hobson would like to make an appointment to access the fire hall to determine if the generator can handle both the hall and fire hall. Steve Crusoe contacted Archambo Electric for a bid.

PIE & G Franchise Agreement – Teresa Sullivan stated that Attorney Tim MacArthur is working with PIE&G attorney on the agreement verbiage.

**New Business**

2025 Gravel Purchase – Teresa Sullivan stated that she received another invoice for gravel. The invoice had more gravel placed on White Cedar Road after there was gravel put down in the spring. Chuck Maziasz stated that the road needed more. He stated that it is very important that we keep our roads in good shape and if a resident has concerns about a road, they should contact him.

ARPA – Dana Stempky stated that she would like to transfer the remaining \$1,622.01 ARPA funds to the general fund that could be used towards the new flagpole. Board agreed to the transfer.
