Nadine Delana Library Representative - excused

Dale Clarmont, Cheboygan County Commissioner – Reported to the board of the highlights from the meetings: The front door at the County building was upgraded, Policies were updated, Arbor Masters was hired to clean up ice storm debris from drop off stations, Fairground Event Agreement, NLEA 2025 update, 9-day Voting Agreement passed, three resolutions adopted for DHA, District Health Department #4, and Cheboygan County Humane Society, Judge Gauthier withdrew the solar permit in Grant township, Veterans dinner at the Chateau and update on the Cheboygan dam. Consumers Power is working on restoring the electric turbine.

Long Lake Special Assessment

Jeff Sherman President & Attorney Tim MacArthur – Discussion was held regarding the excess funds in the account after the Special Assessment ended. What are the options: refund the funds and do another Special Assessment or carry over the funds for 2026 expenditures, and possibly 2027. The residents need to be informed of the options. Jeff Sherman drafted a letter that will be sent to the Special Assessment residents regarding the excess funds asking if they would like the funds to remain in the account to use for future expenditures or if they want a refund. Attorney Tim MacArthur will review the letter for any other additional information that needs to be included. Discussion if a refund is requested, what is the target date to send funds back and when the next Special Assessment should start so funding is always available. It was stated that the next Special Assessment should have verbiage regarding excess funds after the expiration of the Special Assessment so it is clear to the residents what will happen to the funds. The treatment for 2026 is unknown at this time and expense could be much higher to treat for other issues. Long Lake Association is having another test done.
